**burin:** n. a chisel of tempered steel with a sharp point; used for engraving

**cadenza:** n. a brilliant solo passage occurring near the end of a piece of music

**cajolery:** n. flattery intended to persuade

**cantata:** n. story or poem set to music that can be sung by chorus

**cantonment:** n. temporary living quarters specially built by the army for soldiers

**cacophonous:** a. discordant; inharmonious; sounding harshly; ill-sounding

**caitiff:** a. despicably mean and cowardly

**calcimine:** n. a water-base paint containing zinc oxide and glue and coloring; used as a wash for walls and ceilings
