cathode: n. a negatively charged electrode that is the source of electrons entering an electrical device

centurion: n. officer of ancient Roman army, in command of a century of soldiers or minor division

circumlocution: n. indirect or roundabout expression; evasion in speech or writing

coagulant: n. an agent that produces coagulation
