render: v. deliver; give or make available; provide; represent in a drawing or painting

repatriate: v. restore or return to the country of birth, citizenship, or origin

rescue: n. free from harm or evil; take from legal custody by force

reminisce: v. recollect and tell of past experiences or events; talk or write about memories of the past, especially pleasant memories

remorse: n. pain of a guilty conscience; feeling of deep regret

rendezvous: n. meeting at a prearranged time and place; popular gathering place; prearranged meeting point for troops or ships

repertoire: n. list of works of music or drama; class of compositions in a genre; range or number of skills

reservoir: n. tank used for collecting and storing a liquid; holding pond; lake used to store water for community use
