exacerbate: v. increase severity, violence, or bitterness of; aggravate

exalted: a. superior; elevated in rank, character, or status; of high moral or intellectual value

exonerate: v. acquit; free from blame; discharge from duty

expatriate: n. someone who has withdrawn from his native land

expediency: n. the quality of being convenient and practical despite possibly being improper or immoral

expedite: v. process fast and efficiently; execute quickly and efficiently

expressive: a. effectively conveying thought or feeling; indicative

extradition: n. surrender of prisoner by one state to another; delivery by one state to another

fabrication: n. making something a product from raw materials; the action or process of manufacturing or inventing something
