**grandiose:** a. impressive from inherent grandeur; large and impressive, in size, scope or extent

**gregarious:** a. sociable; seeking and enjoying the company of others

**grisly:** a. frightfully; terribly; causing horror or disgust

**guile:** n. skillful deceit; disposition to deceive or cheat; disguise cunningly

**hackneyed:** a. repeated too often; over familiar through overuse

**heyday:** n. period of greatest popularity, success, or power; golden age

**hiatus:** n. gap; interruption in duration or continuity; pause

**hierarchy:** n. arrangement by rank or standing; series in which each element is graded or ranked

**homogenous:** a. all of the same or similar kind or nature

**hyperbole:** n. figure of speech in which exaggeration is used for emphasis; overstatement

**ideology:** n. study of origin and nature of ideas

**idiosyncrasy:** n. behavioral attribute that is distinctive and peculiar to an individual
